- The papers should be be in Word format.
- The paper proposal and full paper versions must be sent to e-mail address: kaderkova@jamu.cz
- The full version of papers should not exceed 15 pages including notes and bibliography (see below). The abstract and key words (10-15 lines) are also required.
- The redaction retains the right to make linguistic corrections.
- Authors have the possibility to make stylistic or other changes before sending the text (deadline for sending a full paper version is October 15<sup>th</sup> 2011).
